System One Complete Audio System



Rega's first and only complete hi-fi system in a box is an expression of the British company's ethos to offer high-performance, built-to-last products at affordable prices.

At its heart is Rega's most affordable turntable; the P1 is a full-size record player with a proper dust cover and high-quality motor, bearing, platter, arm and cartridge.

Developed for this system package, the io is a 30-watt integrated amplifier, based on the same circuit as the company's remarkable mid-range Brio, and featuring a headphone output, remote control, two line inputs and that all-important MM phono stage. Lastly, the Kyte loudspeaker eschews wood almost entirely in favour of a Rega favourite – plastic, phenolic resin – and combines a 125mm mid/bass paper cone driver with Rega's ZRR soft-dome tweeter.

Together, the trio does what Rega products have been doing for decades: produce "a musically coherent and thoroughly engaging listening experience". For this money, you'd be hard-pushed to find the sonic coherence, build quality and lifetime guarantee offered here elsewhere.

But critically, Rega also does its utmost to keep its products affordable to the man and woman in the street. The company's design philosophy is built on the principle of 'light and stiff.' Rejecting the industry trend of heavy mass, Rega believes that weight traps energy and colors sound. Instead, it uses lightweight, rigid materials like phenolic resin and ceramic to dissipate vibration quickly. Rega's engineering-led approach emphasises simplicity, reliability, and value, avoiding unnecessary features that compromise the signal path.

From its iconic hand-assembled tonearms to its integrated amplifiers, Rega focuses on mechanical integrity and musical timing, aiming to deliver a high-performance, emotive listening experience that remains accessible to music lovers at every price point.
